



**For Options 2 and 3, close contacts should monitor for symptoms and follow mitigation strategies (correct and consistent mask use, physical distancing, hand and cough hygiene, avoiding crowds, etc.) until 14 days after exposure. Close contacts should not participate in any in-school or extracurricular activities that cannot be performed while masked or distanced until completion of the 14-day period.*

NOTE: If student remains asymptomatic, it is the parent's choice to have them tested, but a negative test on or after day 5 will allow them to participate in extracurricular activities after day 7 or after day 10 without a test, but participating wearing a mask.
